This conduct is unlawful under both provincial and federal law, and it constitutes actionable harassment, cyberbullying, and defamation. Your actions have caused Mr. Froot measurable harm, including reputational damage and emotional distress, and he is prepared to pursue all legal remedies available to him.

Accordingly, you are hereby directed to IMMEDIATELY CEASE AND DESIST from:

1. Making any further public or private communications concerning Mr. Froot;
2. Engaging in or encouraging any further online activity that refers to or targets Mr. Froot in any manner;
3. Contacting Mr. Froot directly or indirectly through any medium;
4. Interfering with Mr. Froot's relationships, employment, or reputation in any capacity.

If you do not fully comply with this demand by May 15, 2025, our client will have no choice but to initiate

formal legal proceedings against you, including a civil action for damages and a request for injunctive relief. You may also be reported to relevant enforcement agencies and internet platforms for violations of applicable laws and terms of service.

This letter is written without prejudice to any of Mr. Froot's rights or remedies, all of which are expressly reserved.

We strongly advise you to seek independent legal counsel regarding this matter.
